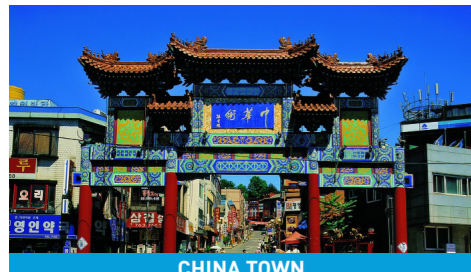

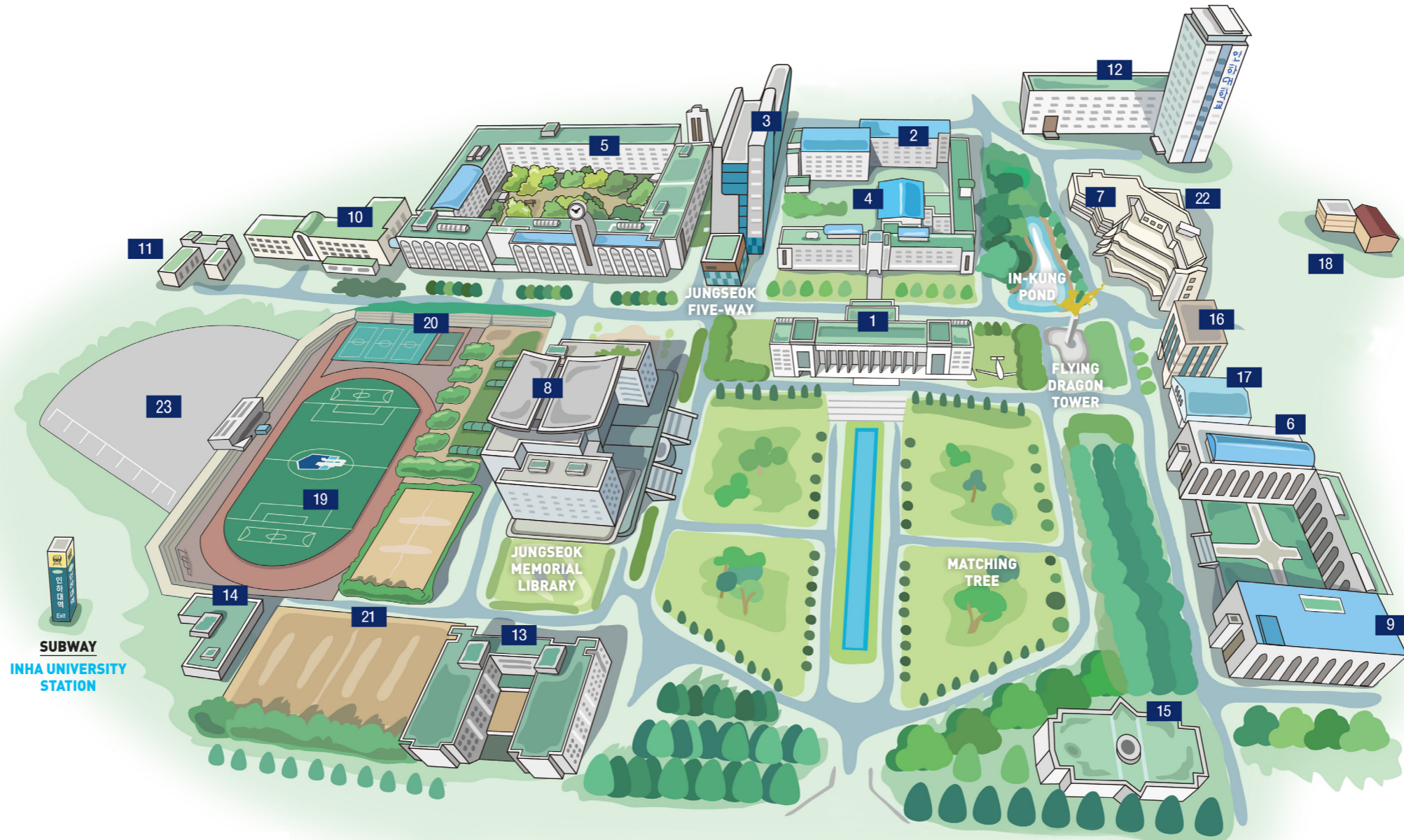

### IN-KUNG POND

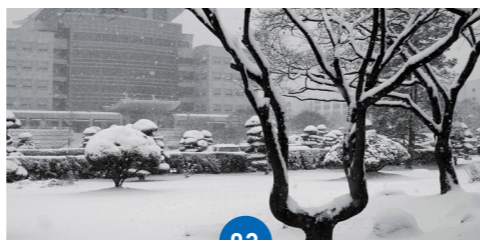

### MATCHING TREE

### FLYING DRAGON TOWER, ECHO STONE

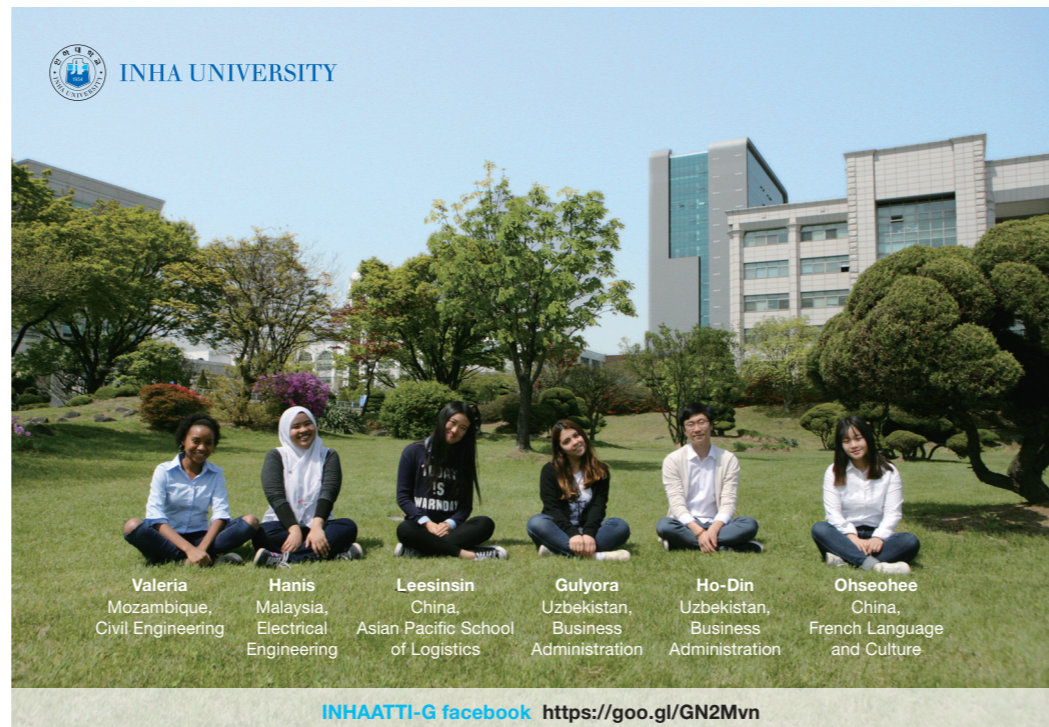
